

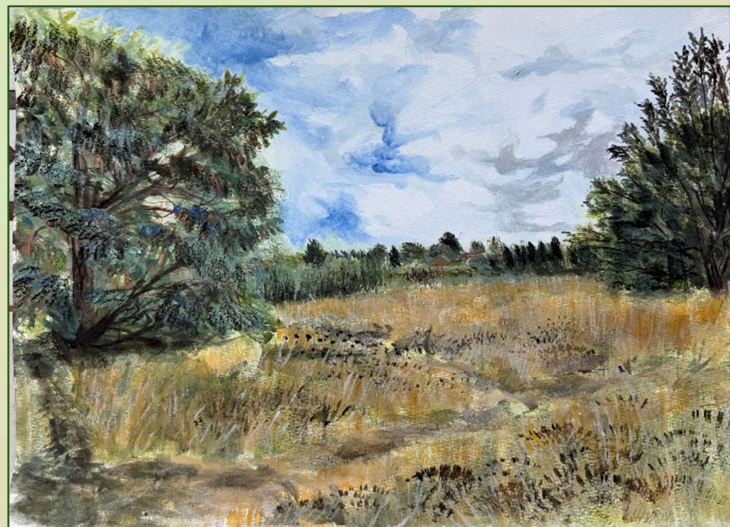
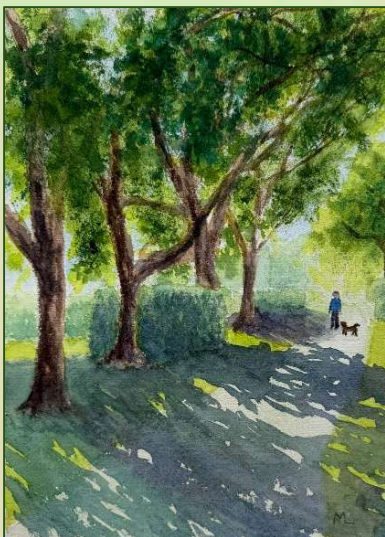


Queen Mary's Park – Sutton Parks - Landscape Artist of the Year Competition 2026

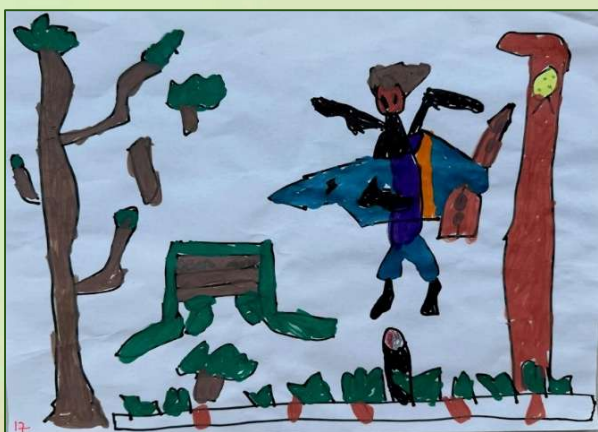
